Nakimu Caves – Glacier National Park

July 24, August 14 and 28 and September 11, 2010

Cost - \$60.00 Members \$80.00 Non Members

Explore the Nakimu Caves System in Glacier National Park. Be prepared for a very long, strenuous day, as we'll hike Balu Pass and drop into Cougar Valley early morning, (for approximately 2.5 hrs), then explore the cave system for 2-3 hours. The cave is wet and has tight, confined spaces. The hike back out, takes approximately 2 hours, so this trip is usually a 12 hour day. Starts at 6:30 a.m. from the Rogers Pass Discovery Center parking lot. Minimum group size is 6 with maximum of 12.
