All applicants will receive notice of who was awarded the Research Grant. The award will be announced on April 15 of each year.

Intent of Research Grant:

1. To assist a Canadian University Graduate student participating in research which promotes:
 - Better knowledge and understanding of the North Columbia Mountains ecosystem and its components, or
 - Better knowledge and understanding of the human history and cultural significance of human activities in this region.
2. Funds are to be used for living expenses while in the area, fieldwork expenses or research supplies and equipment.
3. This Grant is meant to assist students lacking adequate financial support to undertake research.

Qualifications:

1. The student must be registered in a graduate research program at a Canadian university.
2. The student must apply in writing. Refer to the information requested on the following page.
3. The field research must be conducted within the Columbia Mountain Region, preferably near Mount Revelstoke and Glacier National Parks.

Review of Applicants

Applications will be reviewed and ranked by a committee of Friends of Mount Revelstoke & Glacier members. The Board of Directors of the Friends will make the final selection. Advice may be sought from agencies such as the Columbia Mountain Institute of Applied Ecology, Heritage Conservation Branch of BC and Parks Canada.
