# WHAT we do...

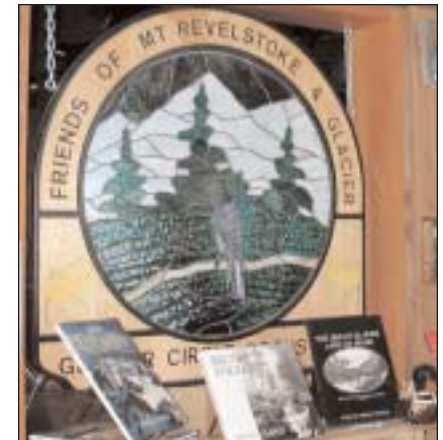
To promote the understanding and appreciation of the natural environment found in our parks we support and encourage many projects and activities, such as:
